## **Your PMU Consultation – £20**

Your consultation includes:

- Skin & suitability assessment
- Shape and design discussion
- Colour planning
- Patch test

The £20 consultation fee is deducted from your treatment price if you proceed. You may also book a consultation with no obligation to continue.

---

## **Booking Your PMU Treatment**

You can secure your PMU appointment in two ways:

Option 1 – Pay in Full

- Pay the full treatment price before or on your first session.

Option 2 – 50/50 Split Payment

- Pay 50% of your treatment price to secure your appointment
- Pay the remaining 50% at your first session

Your perfecting session is included in the treatment cost.

## **What's Included in Your PMU Treatment**

- Full bespoke mapping & design tailored to your face
  - Custom pigment colour selection
  - First PMU treatment session
  - Perfecting session included (usually 6–8 weeks later, if required)
  - Aftercare guidance & support
  - Healed check-in advice
- 

## **Aftercare Responsibility**

Proper aftercare is essential for achieving the best healed results. Failure to follow aftercare guidance may affect results and could require an additional session.



## Colour Boost Plans

Permanent makeup fades naturally over time, Colour Boost sessions are recommended every 12 - 18 months.

Brows, Lips & Liner £160 - You are always in control of how you maintain your PMU. Colour Boost Plans are available for clients who prefer to spread the cost of maintenance over time, however you can also choose to book and pay for a Colour Boost as a one-off when required.

Monthly Plans:

### 12-Month Plan

- £13.33 per month
- Colour boost available once 12 payments are completed

### 18-Month Plan

- £8.88 per month
- Colour boost available once 18 payments are completed

Plan Variations

- Lash Enhancement Colour Boost: £10pm (£120)
- Daily Liner Colour Boost: £11.66pm (£140)

Lips and Eyeliner – optional 24-month plan

## Multi-Area Colour Boost Discounts

If you plan to boost more than one PMU area:

- 10% off your second Colour Boost Plan
- 15% off your third

Each PMU area has its own renewal cycle and colour-boost schedule.

---

## Colour Boost Booking Rules

- Plans must be fully paid or up to date before booking
- Earlier appointments can be booked by clearing any remaining balance
- Plans are non-transferable
- No refunds for partially used plans
- Colour boost appointments follow the standard cancellation policy



## Referral Benefit for Colour Boost Clients

If you refer someone who books a full PMU treatment, you receive:

- 10% off your next Colour Boost Plan (one per year)

This applies to future plan renewals, not the current one.

If you're not on a plan, the reward can be applied to your next colour boost paid in full.

### BROWS

All styles £350 / CB £160

### LIPS

Sheer £300 / CB £145

Velvet £325 / CB £160

Frozen £350 / CB £175

### EYELINER – TOP ONLY

Lash enhancement £225 / CB £120

Daily liner from £250 / CB £140

Winged liner from £275 / CB £160

Daily liner & shading £300 / CB £160

Winged liner & shading £325 / CB £160

### EYELINER – BOTTOM

Lash enhancement £175 / CB £100

Daily liner from £200 / CB £120

Eyeliners prices depend on thickness – natural, make up or glam etc.  
(dependant on eye structure)

Deduct £75 when booking top and bottom liner / colour boosts as priced.

## Cancellation & Rescheduling Policy

- 48 hours' notice required
- Late cancellations or missed appointments may incur a fee
- Please arrive on time
- All bookings require secure card details or an active plan

## **BROWS – PRE & AFTERCARE (SUMMARY)**

### Pre-Care (Key Points)

- Brow tinting, waxing or threading must be completed at least 48 hours before treatment
- Avoid retinol, acids or active skincare on the brow area for 8 weeks prior
- No Botox, fillers or aesthetics for 2 weeks before and after
- Do not attend if you are on antibiotics
- Avoid vaccinations for 2 weeks prior
- Keep skin hydrated and use a broad-spectrum SPF

### On the Day

- Attend in good health and not pregnant
- Eat beforehand to support blood sugar levels
- Avoid alcohol, aspirin, ibuprofen and excessive caffeine the night before

### Aftercare (Summary)

- Expect redness, swelling or dark colour initially – this is normal
- Do not pick, scratch or pull at the area
- Avoid sweating, swimming, sun exposure and makeup until healed
- Results will soften and settle over 4–6 weeks

➔ Full pre & post care instructions will be provided prior to your appointment.

---

## **LIPS – PRE & AFTERCARE (SUMMARY)**

### Pre-Care (Key Points)

- Keep lips well hydrated for 1–2 weeks prior
- Avoid retinol or active skincare around the mouth for 8 weeks
- Do not attend if on antibiotics
- Avoid vaccinations for 2 weeks prior

### Cold Sores

If you are prone to cold sores or have had one previously, anti-viral medication is essential to take before and after treatment. This will be discussed during your consultation.

### On the Day

- Attend in good health and not pregnant
- Eat beforehand
- Avoid alcohol, aspirin, ibuprofen and caffeine the night before

### Aftercare (Summary)

- Swelling and tenderness are normal
- Avoid spicy, salty foods, kissing and drinking from a straw initially
- Colour will appear darker before softening
- Final healed colour can take up to 8–12 weeks

➔ Full lip-specific aftercare will be provided prior to treatment.

---

## **EYELINER – PRE & AFTERCARE (SUMMARY)**

### Pre-Care (Key Points)

- Discontinue lash growth serums 3–6 months prior
- No lash extensions for at least 1 week before
- Avoid retinol and active skincare around the eyes for 8 weeks
- Do not attend if on antibiotics
- Avoid vaccinations for 2 weeks prior

### On the Day

- Arrive with no eye makeup
- Remove contact lenses before treatment
- Eat beforehand
- Avoid alcohol, aspirin, ibuprofen and caffeine the night before

### Aftercare (Summary)

- Swelling and tenderness are common for the first few days
- Avoid makeup, swimming, sweating and sun exposure until healed
- Colour will initially appear darker before softening
- SPF is recommended once healed

➔ Full eyeliner aftercare instructions will be sent prior to your appointment.
